Christmas Light Up winners announced

Christmas Light Up winners announced

Thursday, 11 December 2003 - Jean and Paul Phillips of 14 Aethalia Street, Currumbin Waters, are the grand champions of the recordbreaking Gold Coast City Council Christmas Light Up competition.

The couple won a total of more than \$2250 in the competition, in which more than two million additional light globes from 95 entries illuminate the City's night sky.

They received their prizes today (Thursday, December 11) from Mayor Gary Baildon at a ceremony at Robina Town Centre.

Winners in four categories (best?illuminated residence, best-animated residence, best single feature and best first-year entry) each won more than \$1250 in prizes, with the grand champions, chosen from winners of these categories, receiving an additional \$1000.

All entries now remain switched on throughout the City from 7pm every evening to Christmas Eve.

Official tours by Murrays Coaches on (07) 5561 6444 will be run from Thursday to Christmas Eve, or residents and visitors may tour individually.

Murrays tours, which must be booked, cost \$12 per person, with \$1 donated to the Society of St Vincent de Paul.

In response to the huge interest in the Christmas Light Up tours Murrays Coaches is laying on an additional two tours to the Beenleigh area on December 16 and 22.

Presenting the prizes Mayor Gary Baildon said the competition was special because it was living proof — written in lights — that the Gold Coast was a community.

"A City, certainly, but a city that still knows how to show the heart and spirit that goes with Christmas, and the love of peace and goodwill that has marked this seasonal celebration for 2000 years," said Cr Baildon.

"This is a whole ocean of small homes and large, businesses and churches, single windows and whole streets... all saying to the skies: "Hey, it's Christmas! Let's celebrate."
